

## Exercise Episode 011

The Lovers Meet Scene

inspired by the song:

"Ain't No Other Man" by Christina Aguilera

#### TASK:

Create an original "Lovers Meet" scene inspired by Aguilera's song "Ain't No Other Man."

- 1. You are free to use either past or present tense.
- 2. Please use **direct address** to show a one-sided conversation as your song's main character tells their special someone about the moment they met. Just put yourself in your character's shoes and use the pronouns "I" and "you."
- 3. Come up with a **specific problem** the character has to deal with in your song. Is it getting the attention of that special someone? Is there a rival? Are there other people against the relationship? Are there secrets they try to keep from each other? Let your imagination run free.
- 4. Include all **five commandments**. But they do not have to be in order. You can switch them up between your verses, chorus, and pre-chorus.
  - a. So the inciting incident of your character is establishing an event that the character in your song anticipates. That's his/her status quo. Ask yourself: Where are they off to? Where are they heading?
  - b. The turning point will be meeting that special girl or boy for the very first time.
  - c. The crisis must show what's at stake for the character if they let that special someone pass.
  - d. Show the character's decision.
  - e. Include a resolution letting your audience know how it all turned out. Use the third verse for the confession of love after retelling how they first met in the other two verses for setting up the confession of how much they have come to love that person.
- 5. The song must **end positively**.
- 6. Instead of relying on an overconfident **character**, show one that is appreciating the luck they've had.
- 7. Use "Show, don't Tell" and be specific.

#### ABSTRACT BEATS to use in your lyrics

- +++ Establishing the Setting
  - Show your audience where exactly your story moment takes place. Is it in a bar? Dance Academy? An office? In the wilderness? On the battlefield?
- Status Quo
  - What was life before meeting that particular person? Use "Show, don't Tell."
     Be more specific.
- +++ Commandment 1: Inciting Incident: Anticipated Event of the main character
  - Without knowing your character's life is about to change, what are they up to?
- Commandment 2: Turning Point = Lovers first Meet
  - Everything changes as your character meets that one person that makes them forget what they set out to do. Suddenly everything has changed.
  - Give insights into the feelings of the character as they met that special someone.
- Inexplicable first change
  - In what kind of behavior did that initial feeling result?
- Character Action
  - Include a specific action what the main character in your song did after meeting that special someone. Answer the question of how it affected their environment.
- +++ Commandment 3: Crisis = Inner Monologue + showing either something at stake or even telling what is at stake. Even in a positive turn of events, you can lose something.
  - The surroundings demand to act fast if the character in your song wants to use his/her once-in-a-lifetime chance. But what is at stake? What could happen if they fail?
- +++ Commandment 4: Decision
  - After going through the dilemma, show the decision your character has made. Maybe the declaration of love is the decision? Perhaps it's just the way of how to show that person what they feel or that they are interested?
- Commandment 5: Resolution = Confession of Love
  - Include the confession of love but reveal it not in the chorus but in the last verse to keep the tension of how everything turned out. Use the chorus to focus on either the crisis moment or use the verses to paint a better picture of the character's life and use the chorus to highlight the turning point = meeting that special someone.
- Highlight the change.
  - Show how your character and his situation changed by having had the courage to make a decision.
- Romanticizing
